Pick a few questions from below and reflect this week, or choose 4-5 to discuss in your home group.

- Now that we've covered two *Domino* messages, what spiritual lessons do you see when you watch domino tricks? What would be your sermon titles if you were writing the series?
- The following verses were referenced in the message to describe the gospel's momentum: Matt 28:19; 1 Cor 12:3; Rom 8:29. Can you think of others?
- Have someone in your group provide a brief presentation of how the gospel has moved through the centuries.
- Who was most influential in you becoming a Christian?
- In what ways are you serving the body of Christ?
- In what ways are you interacting with people who don't go to church?
- Be honest with the group. What keeps you from maximizing your influence on others? (What keeps you from tipping?)



- How is the *Domino* series influencing your thinking today?
- Read Matt 25:14-23. What observations can you make from the *parable of the talents* about our responsibility to share what God has given us?
- Read Luke 12:16-19. What lessons are contained in the *parable of the rich man* about how we share our resources?
- Other than momentum, can you think of other physics laws affecting domino tricks?
- Based on the message, what things are you thinking might need to change in your life?
- Pray as a group for opportunities to *tip* this week.

We Are Not The First Dominos: DOMINO 1

OVERVIEW

P=mv is about examining ourselves to determine if we are effectively becoming who God has designed us to be, passing on our faith and the gospel to others. A basic understanding of momentum helps us understand why a domino trick works, and how faith is being passed down from generation to generation. (or not) If someone were to ask us, "what were the major influences in you becoming a Jesus follower?" We would likely acknowledge only those influences that most directly influenced us. *Domino* illustrates for us just how vast the investment in our salvation has been, and so, what a heavy responsibility we bear in this generation to *tip our domino* onto the next, and how far-reaching the effects that simple act may be.

We also spent time thinking about some of things that hinder us from taking those *tipping* opportunities that God often presents us with.
