Ephesians 4:31-32 (NLT) Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. ³² Instead, **be kind to each other**, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.

What is bitterness?

A deadly poison of an unforgiving spirit that infects every part of your soul, body and mind.

= Resentment on steroids

Q #1: How do you know if you are bitter?
A: Bitterness remembers details

Q #2: What causes bitterness?
A: Sin: real or perceived

Q #3: Why do you hold on to bitterness?

A: Because you think it's your right
