The Truth: What we actually know is that MICRO evolution is a FACT and MACRO evolution is a THEORY.

LIE 3: The Bible says that God created the universe in SIX, 24-HOUR DAYS, about 6,000 years ago.

The Truth: The Bible clearly says that GOD CREATED the universe and human beings, but it doesn't say HOW. Gen 1:27; 2:7; Ps 139:13

The Truth: The Bible should be interpreted based on WHO it was written to, and according to the GENRE in which it was written.

Genres: Historical, narrative, figurative, literal, prescriptive, prayers, poetry/songs etc.

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
